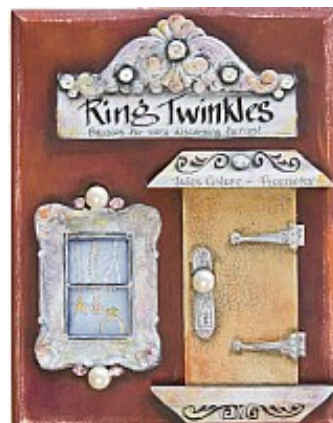

Mr. Mesko's grandfather, Francis Lynch, played amateur baseball with a Pennsylvania coal mining team in 1908 and continued playing for the next three decades with various coal mining and steel mill teams.

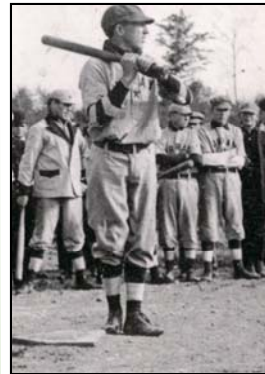

Mr. Mesko is a long-time Detroit resident who holds both a B.F.A. and an M.F.A. from Wayne State University. A former Marine, he is known for his social and political activism. He has shown his work at The Detroit Institute of Arts, and has had one-person shows at Oakland University, Willis Gallery, Zeitgeist Gallery, Marygrove College, and the Michigan Gallery among others.

The show will open with a reception Friday, April 2nd, from 6-9 pm with an artist's talk at 8 pm. The show will continue through April 24th during the Art House Gallery hours (Wednesday-Saturday, 1-5 pm).

In addition, the Friends of the Library will also hold a "used" sports book sale in the lower gallery of the Art House from 6-9 pm on First Friday. Proceeds will benefit both the Friends of the Northville District Library and the Northville Art House.

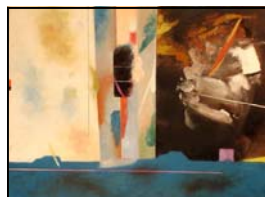

Antiques and Fine Arts Appraisal Clinic May 1



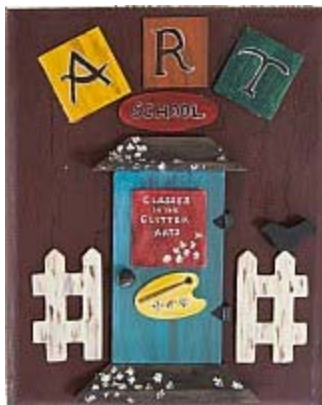
The Northville Arts Commission will host its second annual Appraisal Clinic with proceeds of the event benefitting the cultural and educational programs of the Northville Art House.
