Looking forward to 2010!

- The DDA website was launched eight years ago and is ready for a new look. Watch for the announcement of our new and improved website.
- Plans are underway to create a walkthru from the parking lot in the rear of the Marquis Theatre to E. Main Street. The **East Main Street Walkthru Project** will make your visit to downtown Northville more convenient and is slated for a spring construction start. The walk thru will be located at 125 E. Main in the former Girly Daze location. The pedestrian walkthru was recommended in Northville's 2006 Downtown Strategic Plan.
- Also underway are plans to continue the downtown improvements with the replacement of streets and sidewalks in the immediate downtown area. The **Streetscape Enhancement Project** was also recommended in the Downtown Strategic Plan and is slated for a July 2010 construction start. The project includes new and healthy street trees, retrofitted street lamps with induction lighting and improved signage - all in keeping with the feel of our Victorian heritage.
