A New Way to Dine in Downtown Northville!

City Council recently approved changes to Downtown Northville's current Outdoor Seating Ordinance to include Platform Dining.

Outdoor platforms are constructed in the parking space and overlap the sidewalk in front of the restaurant for use as outdoor dining space. This concept is a great way to expand outdoor dining where sidewalks are narrow and, at the same time, allow ample space for sidewalk pedestrian traffic. Platforms are permitted throughout the outdoor dining season, April through October, and will be removed for the winter months making those parking spaces available for holiday shoppers.

Two platforms are currently in place at Table 5 (126 E. Main) and next door at Le George (124 E. Main). Le George will be opening in the next few weeks serving a full menu of Mediterranean cuisine.
