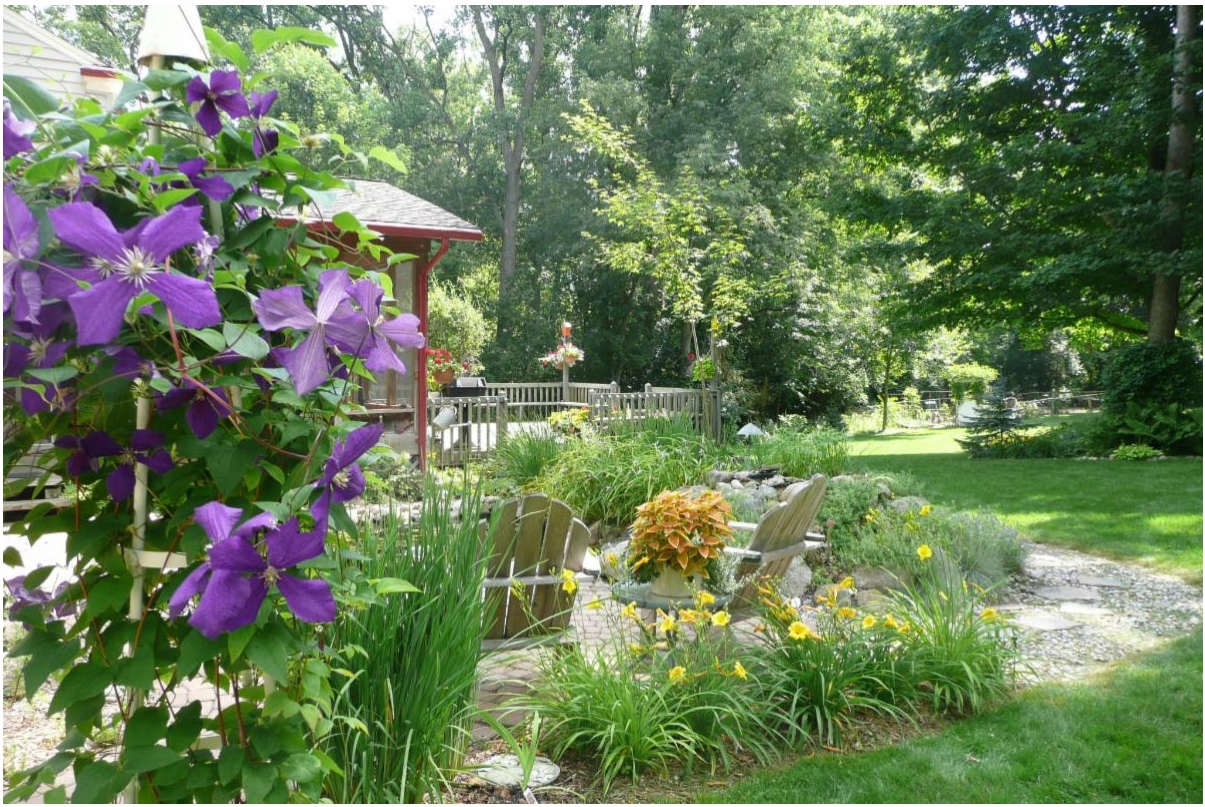


32nd Annual Northville Garden Walk

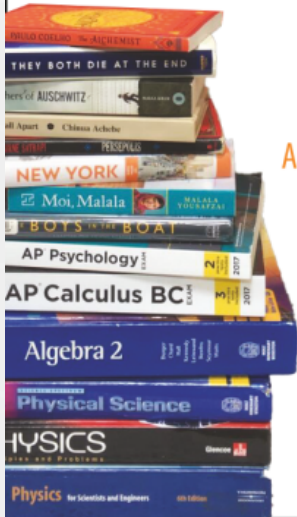
