The skeletons, created by Begonia Brothers of Northville, will be exhibited throughout the month of October. The city will kick off the 10th anniversary of **Skeletons Are Alive!** with a launch party in Town Square (across from the Marquis Theatre on Main Street) on Friday, October 1, from 6:00 – 9:00 pm.


Residents and friends of Northville are invited to join the festivities on October 1st. Halloween costumes encouraged! The Northville Downtown Development Authority is excited to welcome the boney guests back to town with food trucks, music and entertainment. Since opening in June of 2019, Stemville's mission has been to create a play center for children that encourages the use of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Children use creative thinking and problem solving as they explore the various play stations. As Albert Einstein famously said, "play is the highest form of research." Stemville encourages and stimulates the minds of all the children who visit so they too can imagine, explore, design, and create.

Within the creative space located in Downtown Northville, Stemville offers over 25,000 Magformers, 7,500 Clicformers, coding robots, numerous STEM stations, and an 8-foot LiteZilla so children can watch their design light up. Stemville also offers new STEM challenges and a monthly STEM patch activity. "We want to keep our programming fresh and exciting so children are excited to return and try something new. We want them to think and grow creatively." states Andreea Harrington, co-owner of Stemville.

Not just a place for children, Stemville also offers its adult guests complimentary Wifi, and an on-site coffee and snack bar. The snack bar is stocked with healthy and organic grab-and-go snacks and the coffee is provided through Great Lakes Coffee Roasting Company. There are plenty of comfy seats and chairs with a clear sight line of the open play space. (Parents must remain present in the room and are responsible for their children, except during camps, classes, and some special events.)

Health and safety have always been guiding principles at Stemville. Before they opened their doors, the co-owners Andreea and Kristin invested in a Zono Technologies state-of-the-art sanitization cabinet to ensure staff members can effectively sanitize toys and other objects used by children to
