Toria is a brand new bistro and bar in the heart of historic downtown Northville. The name was inspired by Northville's Victorian era heritage. Toria was the granddaughter of the Queen and daughter of King Edward (a nod to the previous business).

Alicia Racine (owner of Adorn Fine Flowers) and her husband Ryan Racine (local musician) opened the new spot in mid-August after almost a year of renovations to the space. The couple wanted to bring a touch of Europe to town with decor that recalls both Parisian Cafes and London Pubs. The space is small and intimate with 28 table seats and 12 bar seats making it perfect for a casual date night or evening with a few friends.

The menu features both shareable "small plates" as well as full entrees and will rotate seasonally. Classic British dishes like Bangers & Mash appear alongside unique creations like the Warm Autumn Panzanella or staples like the Flat Iron Steak with Duck Fat Potatoes. Craft Cocktails and an extensive wine list accompany this small but sophisticated food menu. The bar has a happy hour special Tuesday-Thursday 5-7 of a half dozen Oysters and glass of Champagne for \$16
