Congratulations to the inaugural Chili'in the Ville 2022 Champs – Northville Township Fire Department and Browndog

Last Saturday, approximately 400 guests came out to enjoy chili samples throughout Downtown Northville for the inaugural Chili'in the Ville event. The event was put into motion when Theresa Shilroch and Janine Bauchat at the Dancing Eye Gallery approached the DDA in January with the idea to host a chili cookoff as a way for the community to get out and enjoy the social district during the long, cold days of a Michigan winter.



The heated competition in Town Square featured chili samples from both the City of Northville and Township Fire Departments, resurrecting the old Chamber chili competition between the two departments. Attendees were also able to stop into participating restaurants to sample bite-sized portions of chili. 
